## Dear Parents / Caregivers

The Maidens Park Primary School Board has endorsed the Voluntary Contributions and Charges schedule for 2026.

The schedule is broken into four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that might occur throughout the 2026 school year.

### 1. Contributions (Kindergarten – Year 6)

The School Education Act 1999 sets that the maximum amount of Voluntary Contributions cannot exceed \$60 per child. Maidens Park Primary School have set the amount of contribution, and parents and carers are being asked to pay as low as possible to ensure that the school can still provide a quality environment for children to learn in.

Money collected will supplement school expenditure in the areas listed below. The actual costs per child are shown in the table below. While **Contributions** are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family contributes to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including State and Commonwealth governments.

## 2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components

A breakdown of estimated **charges** for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, activities, etc., for 2026 has been included in the schedule below. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the estimated maximum for activities planned in 2026.

### The charges schedule includes costs associated with

- specific learning activities available to **all** children but conditional on a payment being made, e.g., incursions, excursions, classroom cooking, etc
- specific learning activities available to **selected** children, but conditional on payment, e.g. instrumental music, graduation outing, PEAC, etc.
- other activities are open to **all** children but dependent on payment being made

**Children will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity.**

**As in the past, parents and carers will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.**

School Refund Policy - The school undertakes activities such as excursions, in-school performances, and camps on a self-supporting cost basis. If you have paid for an activity and your child cannot attend, please notify the school as soon as possible. The refund may be credited to the student's account. If the school has incurred a cost for the activity on behalf of a student, this will be deducted from any refund, i.e. bus costs, entry fee etc.

### 3. Items for Personal Use in the Educational Program

The recommended list of materials for personal use ('Booklist') will be given out separately. The charge for **personal use items** will vary from year level to year level and includes:

- Items used by children during lessons, e.g. pencils, markers, calculator
- An additional list may be sent home at the start of the school year

The school's recommended supplier for the 2026 lists is Officeworks. The school receives a 10% commission on sales, not including delivery fees and any other surcharges. The school uses the commission to purchase classroom consumables, e.g. glue sticks, exercise books, scrapbooks, photocopy paper

### 4. Voluntary Approved Funds

Other voluntary approved funds at Maidens Park Primary School include:

- P&C Membership. This membership levy is set at \$1 per family. This levy is paid directly to the P & C.
